

No. 240. THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAW.  
CAP. 142.

The following Rules made by the Village Health Commission of Galata, in the District of Nicosia, and approved by the Commissioner and the Director of Medical Services are published in the *Gazette*.

RULES MADE BY THE VILLAGE HEALTH COMMISSION OF GALATA  
UNDER SECTION 9.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 9 of the Public Health (Villages) Law, Cap. 142, the Village Health Commission of Galata hereby make the following Rules :—

1. These Rules may be cited as the Village Health (Galata) (Amendment) Rules, 1960, and shall be read as one with the Village Health (Galata) Rules, 1938 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Rules”), and the principal Rules and these rules may together be cited as the Village Health (Galata) Rules, 1938 and 1960.

2. Rule 20 of the principal Rules is hereby repealed and substituted by the following rule :—

“Rule 20. The following fees shall be paid by the owner of or the person slaughtering any animal in a slaughter-house, that is to say :—

3. Rule 46 of the principal Rules is hereby repealed and substituted by the following rule :—

“Rule 46.—(1) The following fees shall be paid by every person exposing for sale any fresh meat in the meat market, that is to say :—

| (b) For every carcass of a young lamb or kid or part thereof               | 25          |

(2) The fees in paragraph (1) of this rule prescribed shall not be payable by any person exposing for sale any fresh meat in the meat market, who is a monthly or a yearly lessee of any shop, stall or place in the meat market under rule 45 of these rules.”

4. Rule 54 of the principal Rules is hereby repealed and substituted by the following rule :—

“Rule 54.—(1) The following fee shall be paid by the owner of or the person exposing for sale any carcass of swine or fresh pork in the pork market, that is to say, for every carcass of swine or part thereof or portion of fresh pork 100 mils.

(2) Every such fee shall be paid to the Inspector.”

5. Rule 74 of the principal Rules is hereby repealed and substituted by the following rule :—

“74.—(1) The following fee shall be paid by the owner or occupier of any premises for the removal by persons appointed by the Village Health Commission of buckets or receptacles containing household refuse or manure within the area of the village, that is to say :—

For every bucket or receptacle of household refuse or manure for a period of one year or part thereof not exceeding £3.000 to be assessed by the Village Health Commission.

(2) Every such fee shall be paid to the person authorized by the Village Health Commission in that behalf.”

6. Rule 82 of the principal Rules is hereby repealed and substituted by the following rule :—

“Rule 82. There shall be paid by every occupier in the village in

every year a rate not exceeding £10.000 to be assessed by the Village Health Commission according to the means of each such occupier."

7. Rule 83 of the principal Rules is hereby repealed and substituted by the following rule :—

"Rule 83. The Village Health Commission shall on or before the 1st day of September in each year prepare a list (hereinafter in this part of these Rules referred to as "the Occupiers' List"), showing the name, occupation and place of abode of every occupier in the village and the amount of the annual rate assessed on each such occupier. The Occupiers' List shall be dated and signed by the Chairman of the Village Health Commission."

8. Rule 87 of the principal Rules is hereby repealed and substituted by the following rule :—

"Rule 87. Every occupier in the village whose name appears in the Occupiers' List shall on or before the 31st day of December pay to the Chairman of the Village Health Commission or to such other person as may be appointed Treasurer by the Commissioner, the amount of the annual rate assessed on such occupier."

9. The principal Rules are amended by the insertion immediately after Rule 95 of the following rules :—

"Rule 96.—(1) Within the area of the village no theatre, building, tent or place shall be used for the performance of any stage play or cinematograph exhibition, for dancing, for any entertainment to which the public is admitted or for any public meeting without a licence first obtained therefor from the Village Health Commission or the person authorized by the Village Health Commission in that behalf."

(2) Such licence may be granted either for a single performance, cinematograph exhibition, dance, entertainment or public meeting or for any period not exceeding six months.

(3) Any licence granted under this rule shall be granted to the owner, lessee or occupier of the premises and shall be in such form as the Village Health Commission may from time to time approve.

97.—(1) The following fees shall be paid by every person obtaining a licence under this part of these rules, that is to say :—

- (a) For a period of one month a fee, to be determined in each case by the Village Health Commission, not exceeding £6 ;
- (b) For a period of one week a fee, to be determined in each case by the Village Health Commission, not exceeding £3 ;
- (c) For a single performance, cinematograph exhibition, dance, entertainment or public meeting a fee, to be determined in each case by the Village Health Commission, not exceeding £2.

(2) Every such fee shall be paid to the person authorized by the Village Health Commission in that behalf."
