every year a rate not exceeding £10.000 to be assessed by the Village Health Commission according to the means of each such occupier."

7. Rule 83 of the principal Rules is hereby repealed and substituted

by the following rule:

"Rule 83. The Village Health Commission shall on or before the 1st day of September in each year prepare a list (hereinafter in this part of these Rules referred to as "the Occupiers' List"), showing the name, occupation and place of abode of every occupier in the village and the amount of the annual rate assessed on each such occupier. The Occupiers' List shall be dated and signed by the Chairman of the Village Health Commission."

8. Rule 87 of the principal Rules is hereby repealed and substituted

by the following rule:

"Rule 87. Every occupier in the village whose name appears in the Occupiers' List shall on or before the 31st day of December pay to the Chairman of the Village Health Commission or to such other person as may be appointed Treasurer by the Commissioner, the amount of the annual rate assessed on such occupier."

9. The principal Rules are amended by the insertion immediately after

Rule 95 of the following rules:—

"Rule 96.--(1) Within the area of the village no theatre, building, tent or place shall be used for the performance of any stage play or cinematograph exhibition, for dancing, for any entertainment to which the public is admitted or for any public meeting without a licence first obtained therefor from the Village Health Commission or the person authorized by the Village Health Commission in that behalf."

(2) Such licence may be granted either for a single performance, cinematograph exhibition, dance, entertainment or public meeting or for

any period not exceeding six months.

(3) Any licence granted under this rule shall be granted to the owner, lessee or occupier of the premises and shall be in such form as the Village Health Commission may from time to time approve.

97.—(1) The following fees shall be paid by every person obtaining

a licence under this part of these rules, that is to say :-

(a) For a period of one month a fee, to be determined in each case by the Village Health Commission, not exceeding £6;

(b) For a period of one week a fee, to be determined in each case by

the Village Health Commission, not exceeding £3;

(c) For a single performance, cinematograph exhibition, dance, entertainment or public meeting a fee, to be determined in each case by the Village Health Commission, not exceeding £2.

(2) Every such fee shall be paid to the person authorized by the

Village Health Commission in that behalf."

In pursuance of the provisions of section 19 of the Irrigation Divisions (Villages) Law, the following rules made by the Committee of the Irrigation Division of Syrianokhori, in the District of Nicosia, are published in the Gazette.

## IRRIGATION DIVISION OF SYRIANOKHORI.

Rules.

These rules may be cited as the Irrigation Division of Syrianokhori P.I.: (Amendment) Rules, 1960, and shall be read as one with the Irrigation 210/ Division of Syrianokhori Rules, 1932 to 1958 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules"), and the principal Rules and these rules may

together be cited as the Irrigation Division of Syrianokhori Rules, 1932 to 1960.

- 2. Rule 4 (c) of the principal Rules is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "five per centum" and the substitution therefor of the words "three per centum".
- 3. Rule 5 of the principal Rules is hereby deleted and substituted by the following new Rule 5:—
  - "5. Every proprietor mentioned in the list shall pay a rate not exceeding £10 per annum, as may be prescribed by the Committee from time to time, for every Government donum of land owned by such proprietor which is benefited or is capable of being benefited by the works:

Provided that the Committee may fix a separate rate for each of the areas of the Irrigation Division known as 'Demma Kokkinoyis', 'Afentika', 'Karapittis', 'Demma Tou Choriou', 'Palamas' and 'Zacharomylos' respectively:

Provided further that in addition to the above-mentioned rates every proprietor mentioned in the list shall pay charges not exceeding £15 per annum, as may be prescribed from time to time by the Committee, for every Government donum of land owned by such proprietor in proportion to the benefit derived from the irrigation works."

## Rules.

P.I.: 12/1947 166/1949. These rules may be cited as the Irrigation Division of Kalokhorio (Klirou) and Klirou (Amendment) Rules, 1960, and shall be read as one with the Irrigation Division of Kalokhorio (Klirou) and Klirou Rules, 1946 and 1949 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules"), and the principal Rules and these rules may together by cited as the Irrigation Division of Kalokhorio (Klirou) and Klirou Rules, 1946 to 1960.

- 2. Rule 15 of the principal Rules is hereby amended by the substitution of a colon for the full stop at the end thereof and the addition of the following provisoes:—
  - "Provided that the Committee may, if it considers proper for the better usage of the water available, with the approval of the Commissioner, specify not later than the 1st day of May in each year by a notice to be published in conspicuous places at the villages of Kalokhorio and Klirou, the area and its extent to which water during the Summer season in each year will be allotted:

Provided further that any expense which may be incurred in connection with any such arrangements shall be borne only by the proprietors benefiting." (M.I.707/59.)
