## THE ALIENS AND IMMIGRATION LAWS, 1952 AND 1956.

## ORDER UNDER SECTION 9 (3).

In exercise of the powers vested in him by subsection (3) of section 9 of the Aliens and Immigration Laws, 1952 and 1956, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order : that passports and British Consular Visas shall be dispensed with in the case of officers, non-commissioned officers and men of the Greek and the Turkish Military Contingent, certified as such in a list duly signed by their respective commanding officer, who are coming to Cyprus for the purpose of participating in the Tripartite Headquarters to be established in Cyprus under the provisions of the proposed Treaty of Alliance between the Republic of Cyprus, Greece and Turkey.

Made at Nicosia this 3rd day of August, 1960.
