## CAP. 59.

## CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 2 of the Charities Law (Cap. 59), His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, hereby certifies that the trustees for the time being of the charity known as "Evgirias Melathron" created and constituted under the provisions of a Trust Deed made in Nicosia on the 4th day of June, 1960, between the Monastery of Kykko through its Abbot Chrysostomos, Mrs. Evgenia Theodotou and "Philoptochos Adelphotis" all of Nicosia (therein referred to as "the Donors") on the one part, and His Beatitude the Archbishop of Cyprus Mons. Makarios III (therein referred to as "the Trustee"), on the other part, have, as from the date hereof, been registered under the aforesaid Law as a corporate body under the title "Evgirias Melathron" with a common seal, the device of which has been approved by the Governor, subject to the conditions and directions contained in the aforesaid Trust Deed and the Regulations made thereunder which have been approved by the Governor.

## THE PORT REGULATION LAW.

## CAP. 275.

## REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 23.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 23 of the Port Regulation Law, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following Regulations: Cap. 275

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Pilotage Regulations, 1960, and shall be read as one with the Pilotage Regulations (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"). S.L. Vol. I  
p. 604.

3. Regulation 2 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended:

- (a) by inserting, after the words "Ministry of Transport" in paragraph (a) thereof, the words "of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland or comparable qualifications acceptable to the Government of the Republic of Cyprus";
- (b) by deleting the words "of British Nationality" in sub-paragraph (b) thereof;
- (c) by re-lettering paragraph (c) thereof as Regulation (b).
