BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF PAPHOS.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by the Municipal Corporations Law, and otherwise, the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Paphos, hereby make the following bye-laws :---

1. These Bye-laws may be cited as the Municipal Corporation (Paphos) Pensions and Gratuities (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1960, and shall be read as one with the Municipal Corporation (Paphos) Pensions and Gratuities

Bye-laws, 1941 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Bye-laws") and the principal Bye-laws and these Bye-laws may together be cited as the Municipal Corporation (Paphos) Pensions and Gratuities Bye-laws, 1941 and 1960.
