Bye-laws, 1941 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Bye-laws") and the principal Bye-laws and these Bye-laws may together be cited as the Municipal Corporation (Paphos) Pensions and Gratuities Bye-laws, 1941 and 1960.

2. Bye-law 2 of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by substituting P.I.: 79/1941 for the definition of "Salary "therein contained the definition following, i.e. :

"' Salary' means the annual salary of an officer as approved by the Commissioner under the provisions of the Law, or where no such approval is required, the annual salary of an officer as may be appointed by the Council plus, in each case, any cost-of-living allowance paid to an officer but so that in no case such allowance to exceed twelve and a half per centum of the salary of any such officer.".

The above Bye-laws have been approved by His Excellency the Governor. (M.I. 691/59/2.)

Bye-laws made by the Council of the Municipal Corporation OF PAPHOS.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 125A of the Municipal Corporations Law and of every other power thereunto enabling, the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Paphos, with the concurrence of the Chief Constable, hereby make the following Bye-laws :---

1. These Bye-laws may be cited as the Paphos Municipal (Traffic) Gazette: (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1960, and shall be read as one with the Paphos Municipal (Traffic) Bye-laws, 1956 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Bye-laws ") and the principal Bye-laws and these Bye-laws may together be cited as the Paphos Municipal (Traffic) Bye-laws, 1956 and 1960.

2. The proviso to paragraph (o) of bye-law 11 of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the deletion of the word "twenty" in the second line and the substitution therefor of the word "thirty".
