THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS PROTECTION LAW. CAP. 98 AND LAWS 23 OF 1950, 3 OF 1953 AND 57 OF 1955.

Cap. 98 23 of 1950 3 of 1953 57 of 1955. Order made by the Governor under Section 14.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 14 of the Game and Wild Birds Protection Law (as set out in section 3 of Law 57 of 1955), His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Game and Wild Birds Protection (Relaxation) Order, 1960.

2. In this Order—

S.L. Vol. I p. 157. "permitted area" means any area set out in the Appendix to the Close Season (Permitted Areas) Order.

3. The operation of paragraphs (a) and (b) of section 14 of the Game and Wild Birds Protection Law (as set out in section 3 of Law 57 of 1955) is hereby suspended with regard to the shooting of duck, geese and snipe in and around lakes and marshes within a permitted area.

4. This Order shall remain in force until the 31st day of March, 1960, and shall then expire.
