CANCELLATION OF GRANT MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTION 2.

HUGH FOOT,

*Governor.*

Whereas by a grant made by the Governor under section 2 of the Government Lands Law and of any other power thereunto enabling, and published under Notification No. 617 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 13th October, 1955 (hereinafter referred to as "the grant") the land described in the Schedule hereto was granted to Stylianos Haji Iona (hereinafter referred to as "the grantee") subject to the condition, *inter alia*, that upon the grantee ceasing under any circumstances to be the owner of the adjoining private property, the grant will be cancelled forthwith ;

And whereas the grantee has ceased to be the owner of the adjoining private property :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 2 of the Government Lands Law and of any other power thereunto enabling, I, the Governor, do hereby order that the grant be cancelled.

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 2 of the Charities Law (Cap. 59), I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby certify that the trustees for the time being of the charity known as the Cyprus Branch of the British Red Cross Society, created and constituted in 1950 under the authority contained in the Royal Charters granted to the British Red Cross Society in 1908, 1919 and 1955, have as from the date hereof been registered under the aforesaid Law as a corporate body under the title "The Cyprus Branch of the British Red Cross" with a common seal, the device of which has been approved by the Governor, subject to the conditions and directions contained in the aforesaid Royal Charters and the rules made thereunder which have been approved by the Governor.

Given at Nicosia this 8th day of March, 1960.
