On behalf of the Government of the Republic of Cyprus, I would like to refer to my letter dated 6 December 1991, by which the Government of the Republic of Cyprus declared, in accordance with Article 25 of the Convention for the Protection of Human Rights and Fundamental Freedoms of 4 November 1950, that it recognizes, for a new period of three years beginning on 1st January 1992 and ending on 31 December 1994, the competence of the European Commission of Human Rights to receive petitions submitted to the Secretary-General of the Council of Europe subsequent to 31 December 1988, by any person, nongovernmental organisation or group of individuals claiming, in relation to any act or decision occurring or any facts or events arising subsequent to 31 December 1988, to be the victim of a violation of the rights set forth in that Convention and inform that the Government of the Republic of Cyprus has decided by virtue of the decision of the Council of Ministers No. 37.170 of 4 April 1992 to withdraw the reservation contained in the second paragraph of the above-mentioned letter.
