WHEREAS it is necessary to make additional provision for the service for the twelve months ended on the thirty-first day of December, 1923.

1. This Law may be cited as the Supplementary Short title
 Appropriation Law, 1924.

2. There shall be issued and applied to the service of the twelve months ended the thirty-first day of December, 1923, an additional sum not exceeding the sum of twenty-eight thousand seven hundred and sixty-seven pounds for defraying the charges of the Government of Cyprus for such period. The said amount shall be appropriated as follows:—
