1. This Law may be cited as the Advocates (Amendment) short title. Law, 1926, and shall be read as one with the Advocates Law, 1894, (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Law). and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Advocates Laws, 1894 and 1926.

2. The Principal Law, Section 4 (3) is hereby amended Amendment by the addition after the word "diploma" of the words of Law 12 of 1894, section "otherwise than by correspondence" and by the addition 4(3). after the word "Denmark" of the following proviso:-

Provided always that the Legal Board shall be at liberty to grant a certificate of enrolment to any person who shall satisfy the Legal Board that he had entered his name before the 1st day of November, 1925, at such University or Law School with a view to obtaining a diploma which has been recognized by the Legal Board and who has obtained such a diploma and passed his examination under the Advocates Law within a period of four years from the 1st day of November, 1925.

BE it enacted:

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Municipal Councils (Amendment) Law, 1926, and shall be read as one with the Municipal Councils Law, 1885, (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Law), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Municipal Councils Laws, 1885 and 1926.

No telephone to be erected without a permit from the Municipal Council. 2. No person shall place and maintain any telephone under, over, along or across, or any post in or upon, any street or public road within a Municipal area, and, when placed, alter or remove the same without a permit in writing from the Municipal authority provided always that no such permit for the erection of telephones as aforesaid shall be required by the Government.
