BE it enacted :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Customs, Excise and Revenue Law, 1928. Short title.

2. The Customs, Excise and Revenue Law, 1899, section 23, as amended by the Customs, Excise and Revenue Law, 1926, section 2, is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words “ nine shillings and three piastres ” and the substitution therefor of the words “ eleven shillings.” Amendment of Law 22 of 1899, sec. 23, as amended by Law 4 of 1926, sec. 2.

3. The Customs, Excise and Revenue Law, 1899, as amended by the Cyprus (Customs, Excise and Revenue) Order in Council, 1927, and the Customs, Excise and Revenue (No. 2) Law, 1927, shall be read as if the duties imposed in the First Schedule thereof on Tobacco were deleted and the following duties imposed :— Amendment of Law 22 of 1899, First Schedule, as amended by the Cyprus (Customs, Excise and Revenue) Order in Council, 1927, and Law 27 of 1927.

Tobacco, unmanufactured 2s. 4cp. the oke.

Tobacco, manufactured 14s. the oke.

Tobacco, manufactured, cigars . . . 7s. the hundred.

Tobacco, manufactured, cigarettes 22s. the oke.

4. A drawback of Customs Import Duty at the rate of one shilling and four piastres shall be payable to any Tobacco Manufacturer on every oke of cigarettes manufactured in and exported from Cyprus. Provided that no such drawback shall be payable in respect of a quantity of cigarettes of less than one oke in any one consignment. Drawback on cigarettes manufactured in and exported from Cyprus.

BE it enacted :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Spirit Duties Abolition Law, 1928. Short title.

Taking of excise duty on spirits manufactured in the Colony of Cyprus and license duties on stills to be abolished.

Repeal of Law 3 of 1926.

2. From and after the date of the passing of this Law the taking of excise duty on spirits manufactured in the Colony of Cyprus and license duties on stills shall be abolished.

3. The Spirit Duties Law, 1926, is hereby repealed.

A.D. 1928. TO REGULATE THE BURIAL AND EXHUMATION OF CORPSES.

BE it enacted :—

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Public Health (Burial and Exhumation) Law, 1928.

Depth of graves.

2. A person shall not in any burial ground bury or cause or suffer to be buried any corpse in such a manner as to require or allow any part of the coffin or other receptacle containing the corpse to be placed at a less depth than four feet below the level of the surface of the ground adjoining the grave.

Exhumation forbidden without order of Governor.

3. No person shall exhume any corpse without an order of the Governor and except under such terms and conditions with regard to exhumation and re-burial as may be prescribed in such order.

Penalties.

4.—(1) Any person acting in contravention of the provisions of section 2 of this Law shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding ten pounds.

(2) Any person acting in contravention of the provisions of section 3 of this Law or of any of the terms and conditions of an order made thereunder shall be liable on conviction to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months or to a fine not exceeding ten pounds or to both.

Saving.

5. Nothing in this Law contained shall in any way restrict or be construed to restrict the powers conferred upon Coroners by the Coroners Law, 1894.
