BE it enacted :-

1. This Law may be cited as the Adulteration of Produce Short title. Law, 1930, and shall be read as one with the Adulteration of Produce Law, 1926, (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Law), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Adulteration of Produce Laws. 1926 and 1930.

2. The following section shall be substituted for section Amendment 6 of the principal Law :---

"6. Any officer acting on behalf of the Director of Law. Agriculture or any peace officer may examine any produce intended or exposed for sale, and if he suspects produce and such produce to have been adulterated contrary to the provisions of this Law may take a sample thereof for the purpose of further examination and, if necessary, for the purpose of submitting the same for analysis: Provided that if such sample is taken for the purpose of submitting the same for analysis, the said officer or peace officer shall divide such sample into three portions and shall proceed in accordance with the procedure with regard to submission for analysis in section 5 (2) hereof mentioned."

3. The following section shall be substituted for section Amendment 7 of the principal Law :---

"7. Any person who refuses to allow any officer Penalty for acting on behalf of the Director of Agriculture or any allow officer peace officer to examine any produce or take a sample to examine of any produce as provided in section 6 hereof and any take sample person who hinders or obstructs any such officer or and for peace officer or other person in the execution of any officer or duty imposed upon him by this Law, shall be guilty other person. of an offence and on conviction thereof shall be liable to a fine not exceeding ten pounds or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months or to both such fine and imprisonment."
