

(d) Fix penalties not exceeding five pounds for the breach of any regulation ;

(e) Give directions for the disposal of all fines recovered under the provisions of this Law or the regulations.

WHEREAS it is necessary to make additional provision for the service for the twelve months ended on the thirty-first day of December, 1930.

BE it therefore enacted :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Law, 1931. Short title.

2. There shall be issued and applied to the service of the twelve months ended the thirty-first day of December, 1930, an additional sum not exceeding the sum of eight thousand three hundred and twenty-two pounds for defraying the charges of the Government of Cyprus for such period. The said amount shall be appropriated as follows :— Appropriation of £8,322 for twelve months ended 31st December, 1930.

A LAW TO AMEND THE CRIMINAL LAW.

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Cyprus Criminal Code Order in Council, 1928, Amendment Law, 1931, and that Order in Council and this Law may together be cited as the Cyprus Criminal Code, 1928 and 1931.

Amendment of the Criminal Code.

2. The Cyprus Criminal Code Order in Council, 1928, is hereby amended as follows :—

(a) The following sub-section shall be substituted for sub-section 29 (2) ;

“ (2) A person liable to imprisonment for life or any other period may be sentenced for any shorter term, or the Court before which such person is tried may, instead thereof, impose a fine of an amount not exceeding the amount which such Court is empowered to impose.”

(b) The following section shall be substituted for section 32 ;

“ 32. Any person who is convicted of an offence may be adjudged to make compensation to any person injured by his offence. Any such compensation may be either in addition to or in substitution for any other punishment :
