A LAW FURTHER TO AMEND THE MOTOR CAR LAW, 1921. A.D. 1932.

BE it enacted:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Motor Car Short title.  
(Amendment No. 2) Law, 1932, and shall be read as one  
with the Motor Car Law, 1921, as amended by the Motor  
Car (Amendment) Law, 1932, (hereinafter together referred  
to as “the Principal Law”).

2. Section 3 of the Principal Law is hereby further Amendment

amended by the addition thereto of the following sub-  
sections:—

“(i) The issue of tariffs, either of general application  
or for any specified route, fixing maximum fares, as well  
for time as distance and for a whole motor car or for a  
seat therein, to be paid for motor cars plying for hire.

(j) The due publication of such tariffs and the carrying  
and display of same by motor cars plying for hire.”

3. Section 5 of the Principal Law is hereby amended Amendment

Law.  
by the insertion therein of the following words after the  
words “exceeding one year” (line 5):—

“and the Court may order that the licence to drive  
of such person be forfeited or suspended for such period  
as to the Court may seem fit”.

A LAW FURTHER TO AMEND THE PUBLIC LOANS LAW, 1897. A.D. 1932.

BE it enacted:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Public Loans (Amend- Short title.  
ment) Law, 1932, and shall be read as one with the Public  
Loans Laws, 1897 and 1930, (hereinafter called “the  
Principal Law”), and the Principal Law and this Law  
may together be cited as the Public Loans Laws, 1897  
to 1932.

Repeal of section 16 of the Principal Law and substitution of new section.

2. Section 16 of the Principal Law is hereby repealed and the following section substituted therefor:—

“Advances for purchase of seed corn or fodder.

16.—(1) The Loan Commissioners may, on a requisition addressed to them by the Colonial Secretary, advance funds to the Treasurer for the purchase of seed corn or fodder to be lent to agriculturists on their entering into an agreement with the Treasurer as to its repayment in such form as the Treasurer may from time to time determine.

(2) Every such agreement—

(a) Shall be subject to such terms and conditions and for such period as the Treasurer may from time to time determine;

(b) Shall provide for interest at a rate not exceeding five per centum per annum;

(c) May, if the Treasurer thinks fit, contain provision for the repayment in kind of the seed corn or fodder lent.

(3) The Treasurer may require every such agreement to be secured in such manner as he may prescribe.

(4) The Treasurer shall account to the Loan Commissioners for the proceeds, both principal and interest, of every such loan.”
