BE it enacted :-

1. This Law may be cited as the Indemnity Law, 1932. Short title.

2. No action, prosecution, or legal proceeding whatsoever No legal shall be brought, instituted, or maintained against the proceedings Governor or against any person acting under him in any brought in command or capacity, civil or military, or in pursuance of respect of acts done any orders, general or special, given by him in that behalf, for public for or on account of or in respect of any acts, matters or things whatsoever in good faith advised, commanded, ordered, directed, or done for the maintenance of good order and government or for the public safety of Cyprus between the 21st October, 1931, and the 31st December. 1932, both inclusive.

3. Every such person aforesaid by whom any such act, Persons who matter, or thing shall have been advised, commanded, have done ordered, directed, or done for the purposes aforesaid shall be acquitted. be freed, acquitted, discharged, released and indemnified against all and every person whomsoever in respect thereof.

4. Every such act, matter or thing referred to in the Such acts to preceding sections shall be presumed to have been advised, be presumed to have been commanded, ordered, directed, or done, as the case may done in good be, in good faith, until the contrary shall have been faith. proved by the party complaining.
