BE it enacted :--

Abolition Law, 1934.

Short title.

Sheep and pigs taxes abolished.

Repeal and

saving.

2. From and after the first day of January one thousand nine hundred and thirty-four no enumeration of sheep or pigs for the purpose of taxation shall be made and no tax shall be levied or paid thereon.

1. This Law may be cited as the Sheep and Pigs Tax

3. The enactments set out in the Schedule to this Law are hereby repealed to the extent specified in the second column of that Schedule:

Provided that all taxes on sheep or pigs payable under any enactment hereby repealed which are still due and unpaid on the coming into operation of this Law, shall be collected and paid as if this Law had not been enacted.
