A LAW TO AMEND THE TOBACCO LAWS, 1932 AND 1933.

BE it enacted :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Tobacco (Amendment) Law, 1934, and shall be read as one with the Tobacco Laws, 1932 and 1933, (hereinafter called "the Principal Law"), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Tobacco Laws, 1932 to 1934. Short title.

2. Sub-section (2) of section 13 of the Principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion immediately after the words "Any grower who" in line one, of the word "knowingly". Amendment

3. Sub-section (3) of section 21 of the Principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion immediately after the words "Any dealer who" in line one, of the word "knowingly". Amendment

4. Section 27 of the Principal Law is hereby repealed and the following section substituted therefor :— Repeal of
section 27

section.
27. No factory licence shall be issued unless the licensee enters into a bond with such surety as the Comptroller may require, whereby such licensee undertakes to manufacture for export or for local consumption during each and every year commencing from the date of issue of the licence a quantity of not less than four thousand okes of tobacco or in default to pay to the Comptroller for any difference between four thousand okes and the amount manufactured the consumption duty prescribed by section 38 of this Law."

5. Sub-section (3) of section 34 of the Principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion immediately after the words "Any manufacturer who" in line one, of the word "knowingly". Amendment

6. Sub-section (1) (a) of section 40 of the Principal Law is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "two drams or". Amendment

7. Section 59 of the Principal Law is hereby amended by the addition of the following sub-section, the first part thereof being numbered accordingly :—

“(2) In any prosecution under section 13 (2), 21 (3) or 34 (3) where it is proved that the information given was false, the accused shall, unless he shall satisfy the Court to the contrary, be deemed to have given such information knowing the same to be false.”

Saving.

8. Any bond entered into by a licensee before the enactment of this Law shall be valid and effective as if this Law had not been enacted.

This Law came into operation on 16th February, 1934.

BE it enacted :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Charities (Amendment) Law, 1934, and shall be read as one with the Charities Laws, 1925 and 1932, (hereinafter called “the Principal Law”), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Charities Laws, 1925 to 1934.

2. Section 12 of the Principal Law is hereby amended as follows :—

(a) By the deletion of sub-section (2) and by the substitution therefor of the following sub-section :—

“(2) Such enrolment shall be effected by the depositing with the Registrar of the Supreme Court of the deed, will or other instrument.”

(b) By the deletion of sub-section (3) and by the substitution therefor of the following sub-section :—

“(3) A copy certified by the Registrar to be a true copy of a deed, will or other instrument enrolled in his office shall be received as evidence of the contents and enrolment of such deed, will or other instrument.”

(c) By the deletion of sub-section (4).
