BE it enacted :-

Short title.

22 of 1899.

1. This Law may be cited as the Customs, Excise and Revenue Law, 1934, and shall be read as one with the Customs, Excise and Revenue Law, 1899, (hereinafter called "the Principal Law").

Insertion of new section 27A in Law 22 of 1899. 2. The Principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion of the following section immediately after section 27:—

"Export duty on carobs.

27A. From and after the first day of January one thousand nine hundred and thirty-five there shall be levied upon the exportation of carobs an export duty at such rate not exceeding two piastres for each Aleppo Cantar, as the Governor in Council may, from time to time, direct by Order to be published in the Cyprus Gazette."

This Law came into operation on 28th December, 1934.

BE it enacted:—

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Destruction of Rats (Expenses) Repeal Law, 1934.

Repeal and saving. 29 of 1922.

2. The Destruction of Rats (Expenses) Law, 1922, is hereby repealed:

Provided that any sum which may stand to the credit of the Rat Destruction Fund under the provisions of the Law hereby repealed and which remains unexpended at the date of commencement of this Law shall be carried to the general revenue of the Colony.

This Law came into operation on 28th December, 1934.
