A Law further to amend the Law relating to TOBACCO.

BE it enacted:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Tobacco (Amendment) Short title. Law, 1935, and shall be read as one with the Tobacco Laws, 1932 to 1934, (hereinafter called "the Principal Law"), 40 of 1932. and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited 9 of 1934. as the Tobacco Laws, 1932 to 1935.

2. Section 2 of the Principal Law is hereby amended by Amendment the insertion at the end thereof of the following definition:

of section 2 of Law 40 of 1932.

"' yellow-leaf tobacco' means any tobacco grown in Cyprus from seed of the Turkish or oriental type and commonly known in the tobacco trade by that name."

3. The Principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion Insertion of immediately after section 3 of the following section:—

3A in Law 40 of 1932.

"Tobacco seed.

- 3A.—(1) Notwithstanding anything in this Law contained, any person may, without a licence, sow tobacco seed in a seed bed for the purpose of raising tobacco plants.
- (2) Any tobacco plants raised in any seed bed as in sub-section (1) of this section provided shall be either planted out or destroyed before the 31st day of May in each year."
- 4. Section 4 of the Principal Law is hereby amended as Amandment follows:

- (a) By the insertion at the end of sub-section (3) of the following proviso:
 - "Provided that the Director of Agriculture may, in his discretion, refuse to issue a licence to cultivate to any person who has been convicted of an offence under this Law or any amendment thereof."
- (b) By the deletion of sub-section (4).

Amendment of section 10(3) of Law 40 of 1932.

5. Sub-section (3) of section 10 of the Principal Law is hereby amended by the deletion of the word "five" and by the substitution therefor of the word "two".

Amendment of section 40 (1) (a) of Law 40 of 1932.

- **6.** Paragraph (a) of sub-section (1) of section 40 of the Principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion at the end thereof of the following proviso:—
 - "Provided that in any packet of manufactured tobacco made into cigarettes the number of cigarettes shall not exceed twenty for every five drams of manufactured tobacco contained therein."

Insertion of new section 43_A in Law 40 of 1932.

- 7. The Principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion immediately after section 43 of the following section:—
- "Export of yellow-leaf tobacco.
- 43A.—(1) No person shall export yellow-leaf tobacco from Cyprus except under a licence issued to him in accordance with the provisions of sub-section (2) or sub-section (3) of this section.
- (2) The Governor may, subject to such terms and conditions and for such period as he may think fit, grant to any person an exclusive licence to export from Cyprus any grade or quality of yellow-leaf tobacco.
- (3) The Governor may, subject to such terms and conditions and for such period as he may think fit, grant to any person a special licence to export from Cyprus any grade or quality of yellow-leaf tobacco not being a grade or quality in respect of which an exclusive licence under sub-section (2) of this section has been granted and is current.
- (4) Any licence issued under this section may be revoked at any time by the Governor upon breach of or failure to fulfil any of the terms or conditions of such licence.
- (5) Any person who exports or attempts to export yellow-leaf tobacco in contravention of the provisions of this section shall be guilty of an offence and shall on summary conviction be liable to a fine not exceeding fifty pounds and any yellow-leaf tobacco in respect of which the offence has been committed shall be forfeited."

8. Section 52 of the Principal Law is hereby repealed Repeal of and the following section substituted therefor:

"Possession of tobacco or tumbeki by unlicensed persons prohibited.

- 52.—(1) No person shall possess tobacco or substitution tumbeki unless he is a licensed grower, dealer section. or manufacturer or is otherwise licensed under the provisions of this Law.
- (2) Any person acting in contravention of sub-section (1) of this section shall be guilty of an offence and shall on summary conviction be liable to imprisonment not exceeding six months or to a fine not exceeding fifty pounds or to both such imprisonment and fine and

10. Section 65 of the Principal Law is hereby repealed Repeal of and the following section substituted therefor:

"Regulations.

- 65. The Governor in Council may from time to time make regulations to be published in of new the Cyprus Gazette with regard to—
 - (a) the management of tobacco warehouses:
 - (b) the manner in which imported tumbeki may be sold, offered or exposed for sale;
 - (c) the fees to be charged for a licence to cultivate tobacco:
 - (d) generally for the better carrying into effect of the provisions of this Law."

This Law came into operation on 27th February, 1935.
