A.D. 1935. A LAW TO AMEND THE VILLAGE AUTHORITIES LAWS,

BE it enacted:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Village Authorities (Amendment) Law, 1935, and shall be read as one with the Village Authorities Laws, 1931 and 1933, (hereinafter called “the Principal Law”), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Village Authorities Laws, 1931 to 1935.

2. Section 13A of the Principal Law is hereby amended as follows:—

- (a) By the insertion in sub-section (1) immediately after the word “Corporal” of the words “or of any Police officer in charge of a Police Station”.
- (b) By the addition immediately after sub-section (2) of the following sub-section:—

“(3) A Mukhtar who has been specially authorized by the Governor in that behalf may, on the application in writing of an Excise Officer, issue a warrant under his hand authorizing the officer to whom it is addressed to search any dwelling house wherein he has reasonable grounds to believe that tobacco or manufactured tobacco is kept in contravention of the Tobacco Laws, 1932 to 1935, or any law amending or substituted for the same. The Mukhtar issuing the warrant shall authorize the officer to whom it is addressed to execute it either between the hours of sunrise and sunset, or may, if he thinks fit, authorize such person to execute it at any hour.”

This Law came into operation on 15th March, 1935.
