A.D. 1935. A LAW FURTHER TO AMEND THE LAW RELATING TO TOBACCO.

BE it enacted:-

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Tobacco (Amendment No. 2) Law, 1935, and shall be read as one with the Tobacco Laws, 1932 to 1935, (hereinafter called "the Principal Law"), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Tobacco Laws, 1932 to (No. 2) 1935.

Repeal of section 8 of Law 40 of 1932 and "(substitution of of new of section.

2. Section 8 of the Principal Law is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:—

"Grading and baling of tobacco.

8. Any tobacco in the possession of any grower shall, when dry, be graded and baled at such time and in such manner as the Director of Agriculture may prescribe by notice in the Gazette."

Amendment of section 10 (1) of Law 40 of 1932. 3. Sub-section (1) of section 10 of the Principal Law is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:—

year shall, within twenty-one days from such date as may be notified by the Director of Agriculture, be transported at the expense of the grower to any of the Customs Houses at Famagusta, Larnaca, Limassol, Paphos or Kyrenia at the option of the grower:

Provided that the grower may, with the permission of the Comptroller, transport his tobacco for storing in any

tobacco warehouse."

Repeal of the Second Schedule to Law 40 of 1932 and substitution of new section. 4. The Second Schedule to the Principal Law is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:—

"SECOND SCHEDULE.

Provided that the fee payable in respect of a licence issued after the thirtieth day of September in any year shall be one-half of the fees herein prescribed."

This Law came into operation on 11th October, 1935.
