A LAW TO AMEND THE CYPRUS PENSIONS ORDERS IN
COUNCIL, 1929 AND 1931.

BE it enacted:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Cyprus Pensions Order in Council, 1929, (Amendment) Law, 1936, and shall be read as one with the Cyprus Pensions Orders in Council, 1929 and 1931, (hereinafter called "the Order"), and the Order and this Law may together be cited as the Cyprus Pensions Orders and Law, 1929 to 1936. Short title.

2. Section 5 of the Order is hereby repealed and the following section substituted therefor:— Repeal of section 5 of the Order and substitution of new section.

"Pensions, etc., not of right.

5.—(1) No officer shall have an absolute right to compensation for past services or to pension, gratuity or other allowance; nor shall anything in this Order contained limit the right of the Crown to dismiss any officer without compensation.

(2) Where it is established to the satisfaction of the Governor in Council that an officer has been guilty of negligence, irregularity or misconduct, the pension, gratuity or other allowance may be reduced or altogether withheld."

This Law came into operation on 31st March, 1936.
