BE it enacted :—

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Immovable Property (Restriction and Postponement of Sales) (Continuance) Law, 1936.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in section 10 thereof, the Immovable Property (Restriction and Postponement of Sales) Law, 1935, shall continue in force until the 31st day of December, 1937.
