A LAW TO AMEND THE HOTELS LAW, 1935.

[3rd November, 1938. H. R. PALMER,] Governor.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :---

1. This Law may be cited as the Hotels (Amendment) Short title. Law, 1938, and shall be read as one with the Hotels Law, 1935, (hereinafter called "the Principal Law"), and the 12 of 1935. Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Hotels Laws, 1935 and 1938.

2. Section 2 of the Principal Law is hereby amended Amendment 

" ' hotel ' includes a boarding house and any building of 1935. or premises used for the accommodation of the public in which lodgings are provided and provisions are supplied by the keeper or manager thereof."

3. Section 7 of the Principal Law is hereby amended Amendment by the deletion of the proviso thereto and the substitution of Law 12 therefor of the following proviso :---

" Provided-

- (a) that the cancellation of such licence shall not take effect until the expiration of ten days from the date of such cancellation ; and
- (b) that where an appeal has been made against the cancellation of such licence within the period of ten days prescribed by section 9, such cancellation shall not take effect unless and until the appeal has been determined and the Governor in Council confirms such cancellation."

4. Section 8 of the Principal Law is hereby amended by Amendment the deletion of the proviso to sub-section (1) thereof and of section 8 of Law 12 the substitution therefor of the following proviso :---"Provided-

- (a) that the re-classification of such hotel shall not take effect until the expiration of ten days from the date of the notice therefor; and
- (b) that where an appeal has been made against the re-classification of such hotel within the period of ten days prescribed by section 9, such re-classification shall not take effect unless and until the appeal has been determined and the Governor in Council confirms such re-classification."

Amendment of section 12 of Law 12 of 1935.

5. Section 12 of the Principal Law is hereby amended by the deletion of paragraph (a) of sub-section (1) thereof and the substitution therefor of the following paragraph :—

"(a) providing for the classification of hotels and the issue of certificates of classification in respect thereof and prescribing the fees to be paid therefor and the requirements for hotels in each class;"

Amendment of section 15 of Law 12 of 1935.

6. Section 15 of the Principal Law is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following sub-section, the first part thereof being numbered as sub-section (1):—

"(2) Nothing in this Law shall be deemed to apply to any monastery or to any house or premises exclusively used for the boarding of pupils of an Elementary School prescribed under the provisions of the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to (No. 2) 1937, or a Secondary School registered under the provisions of the Secondary Education Laws, 1935 and 1936, or to any house or premises exclusively used for the accommodation or boarding of persons by a charitable institution."
