No. 6 OF 1939.A LAW TO AMEND THE IMMOVABLE PROPERTY
(RESTRICTION AND POSTPONEMENT OF SALES)
LAWS, 1935 AND 1938.H. R. PALMER,
Governor.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Immovable Property (Restriction and Postponement of Sales) (Amendment) Law, 1939, and shall be read as one with the Immovable Property (Restriction and Postponement of Sales) Laws, 1935 and 1938, (hereinafter called "the Principal Law"), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Immovable Property (Restriction and Postponement of Sales) Laws, 1935 to 1939.

2. Section 7 of the Principal Law as enacted in section 3 of the Immovable Property (Restriction and Postponement of Sales) (Amendment) Law, 1938, is hereby amended by the deletion of paragraph (b) of sub-section (2) thereof and by the substitution therefor of the following paragraph:—

“(b) for any lesser period than one year from the date of payment (such period not being less than six months) where the debtor has paid, after the date of the application to the Land Registry Office for the sale of such property but before the date of the sale of such property, a sum bearing such proportion to the ten per centum aforesaid as such lesser period bears to the period of one year.”
