A LAW TO AMEND THE TOBACCO LAWS,
1932 TO (No. 2) 1940.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and
Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as
follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Tobacco (Amendment) Law, 1942, and shall be read as one with the Tobacco Laws, 1932 to (No. 2) 1940, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law"), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Tobacco Laws, 1932 to 1942.

2. Section 4 of the principal Law is hereby amended as follows:—

(a) by the deletion of sub-section (1) and the substitution therefor of the following sub-section:—

“(1) Every person desiring to plant or cultivate tobacco shall, during such period as may be prescribed by the Director of Agriculture by notice in the *Gazette*, apply to the Director of Agriculture for a licence to plant or cultivate tobacco.”;

(b) by the deletion from sub-section (3) of the words “to cultivate”, which appear in line 4 thereof, and the substitution therefor of the words “to plant or cultivate tobacco”;

(c) by the deletion from the proviso to sub-section (3) of the words “to cultivate”, which appear in line 2 thereof, and the substitution therefor of the words “to plant or cultivate tobacco”.
