A LAW TO AMEND THE TRADING WITH THE ENEMY LAWS,

B<sup>E</sup> it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Trading with the Enemy Short title. (Amendment) Law, 1943, and shall be read as one with the Trading with the Enemy Laws, 1939 to 1941, (here- 16 of 1939 inafter referred to as "the principal Law"), and the <sup>21</sup> of 1940 principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the <sup>28</sup> of 1940 Trading with the Enemy Laws, 1939 to 1943.

2. The principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion Insertion of after section 12 of the following section :--

"Transitional provisions as to areas ceasing to be, or to be treated as, enemy territory.

12A.—(1) Where after the coming into force principal of this section any area ceases to be enemy territory as defined in this Law (whether by reason of the occupation thereof by His Majesty or a Power allied with His Majesty or by reason of its no longer being in the occupation of a Power with whom His Majesty is at war, or for any other reason) that area, shall for the purposes of sections 5A, 6, 7 and 9 of this Law and for the purposes of any order made under section 9 of this Law, save as expressly provided by any such order, be treated as if, until such time as the Governor may by order specify, there had been no such cessation.

(2) The foregoing provisions of this section shall, as respects anything done or omitted to be done after the coming into force of this section, apply in relation to any area which ceased to be enemy territory as defined in this Law on or after the 10th day of July, 1943, but before the coming into force of this section, as it applies to any area ceasing to be enemy territory, as so defined, after the coming into force of this section.

Insertion of new section 12A in the principal Law. (3) Where under sub-section (1) of section 2 of this Law (which empowers the Governor by order to direct an area to be treated for the purposes of this Law as enemy territory) an order has been made directing any area to be treated as enemy territory and that order is, whether before or after the coming into force of this section, revoked or varied so that it no longer applies to that area, the foregoing provisions of this section shall, with the necessary adaptations, apply in relation to that area as if, on the revocation, or, as the case may be, the variation, of the order, the area had ceased to be enemy territory as defined in this Law."
