A LAW TO AMEND THE PUBLIC HEALTH (ANTI-MALARIA)
LAW, 1944.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and
Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as
follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Public Health (Anti-Malaria) Amendment Law, 1945, and shall be read as one with the Public Health (Anti-Malaria) Law, 1944, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law") and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Public Health (Anti-Malaria) Laws, 1944 and 1945.

2. Section 6 of the principal Law is hereby repealed, the subsequent sections 7, 8 and 9 being renumbered as sections 6, 7 and 8, respectively.
