No. 9 OF 1946.

A LAW FURTHER TO AMEND THE LAW RELATING TO THE
REGISTRATION OF DENTISTS.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and
Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as
follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Dentists Registration
(Amendment) Law, 1946, and shall be read as one with the
Dentists Registration Laws, 1926 to 1939, (hereinafter
referred to as "the principal Law"), and the principal Law
and this Law may together be cited as the Dentists
Registration Laws, 1926 to 1946.

2. Section 4 of the principal Law is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following sub-section, the first part thereof being numbered as sub-section (1):—

“(2) The Governor in Council may, in exceptional cases, upon the recommendation of the Medical Council, dispense with the residential qualification prescribed in paragraph (ii) of sub-section (1).”

3. Sub-section (2) of section 19 of the principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion therein at the end thereof of the following proviso:—

“Provided that the title of doctor may, with the sanction of the Medical Council, be assumed by any person registered under this Law as a dentist who, in addition to the qualifications set out in section 4, satisfies the Medical Council that he also possesses a licence, degree or diploma of a Doctor in Dentistry.”
