THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS

No. 17 of 1946.

A LAW TO AMEND THE LIMITATION OF ACTIONS LAW, 1945.

DE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Limitation of Actions Short title. (Amendment) Law, 1946, and shall be read as one with the Limitation of Actions Law, 1945, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law"), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Limitation of Actions Laws, 1945 and 1946.

Amendment of section 3 of the principal Law.

- 2. Section 3 of the principal Law is hereby amended as follows:—
 - (a) by the insertion in sub-section (1) thereof, immediately after paragraph (c), of the following paragraph:—

"Book debts (ca) any book debt due to or from a bank, after the expiration of six years from the date on which the cause of action accrued;":

(b) by the insertion in paragraph (e) of sub-section (1) thereof, immediately after the words "book debt" (line 2), of the following words:—

"(other than a book debt as mentioned in

paragraph (ca) hereof)";

(c) by the insertion therein, immediately after subsection (2) thereof, of the following sub-section:—

"(3) For the purposes of paragraph (ca) of sub-section (1) of this section—

'bank' means any company having banking business in the Colony:

'company' includes every company formed and registered under the provisions of the 18 of 1922 Companies (Limited Liability) Laws, 1922 to to 1944, or any Law amending or substituted for the same, and every company incorporated outside the Colony which establishes or has established a place of business within the Colony."
