## THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS

No. 21 of 1946.

A Law to amend the Summer Resorts (Development)

Law, 1938.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Summer Resorts Short title. (Development) Amendment Law, 1946, and shall be read as one with the Summer Resorts (Development) Law, 1938, 7 of 1938 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law"), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Summer Resorts (Development) Laws, 1938 and 1946.

Insertion of new paragraph in section 25 of the principal Law. 2. Section 25 of the principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion therein immediately after paragraph (k) of the following paragraph:—

"(ka) To grant gratuities and pensions to officers and servants of the Board and to establish a provident fund for its non-pensionable employees and regulate contributions to be made to such fund by such employees.

Any such pensions, gratuities or contributions shall be granted or made by the Board in accordance with bye-laws to be made under

section 26."

Amendment of section 28 of the principal Law.

3. Section 28 of the principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion therein at the end thereof of the following

proviso:

"Provided that, where the land is mortgaged or leased or is charged by a judgment creditor, the Commissioner shall cause notice to be served on the mortgagee, lessee or judgment creditor, as the case may be."
