Section 5 of the principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion therein of the following sub-section, the first part of the said section being numbered as sub-section (1):—</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">“(2) For the purposes of this section, the whole of the income derived by any person in respect of gains or profits from any trade or business shall be deemed to be derived from the Colony if the control and management of such trade or business are exercised in the Colony.”</p> | <p>Amendment of section 5 of the principal Law.</p> |
