THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS

A LAW FURTHER TO AMEND THE LAW
RELATING TO MINES.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and
Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as
follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Mines Regulations (Amendment) Law, 1948, and shall be read as one with the Mines Regulations (Amendment) Laws, 1882 to 1938, (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Law”), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Mines Regulations Amendment Laws, 1882 to 1948, and shall be read in conjunction with the Mines Regulations Law, 2 Shaban 1285.

2. The principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion therein immediately after section 9, of the following section:—

“Royalties.

9A. Notwithstanding anything in the said regulations contained, there shall be paid in respect of any mineral substance obtained in the course of any mining operation or in connection with any concession or otherwise under the provisions of such regulations such royalties, to be calculated in such manner and to be paid at such time or times, as the Governor may determine. And so much of the said regulations as may relate to the payment of proportional duties shall be read subject to the provisions of this section.”
