15. The Governor may, by order to be published in the *Gazette*, suspend the operation of this Law or any provision thereof either generally or particularly as respects sheep or goats or pigs, as may be specified in the order.

16. This Law shall come into operation on the 31st day of December, 1948, and, thereupon, the enactments mentioned in the Schedule to this Law shall be repealed to the extent specified therein.

A LAW TO MAKE PROVISION FOR THE LEVYING
OF A TAX ON FREE RANGING GOATS.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Goats (Free Ranging) Tax Law, 1948.

Interpre-
tation.

2. In this Law—

“ free ranging goat ” means any goat not being a goat lawfully kept under the proviso to section 6 of the Goats Laws, 1913 to 1937, (as set out in Laws 18 of 1930 and 31 of 1935) or any law amending or substituted for the same in any town or village declared to be a prescribed village under the provisions of the said Laws.

3. There shall be levied and paid for every free ranging goat a tax of two shillings. Tax on free ranging goats.

4. The tax shall be annual and shall be payable by the owner in respect of every free ranging goat belonging to him and enumerated under the Sheep, Goats and Pigs (Enumeration) Law, 1948, or any law amending or substituted for the same. Tax to be annual.

5. The tax shall be payable on such date or dates during the year of enumeration as the Governor may direct by order published in the *Gazette*: Date of payment of tax.

Provided that whenever the enumeration takes place after the 1st day of April in any year, the Governor may direct that the tax payable in respect of free ranging goats so enumerated shall be paid in the year following the year of such enumeration and such tax shall be deemed to be the tax leviable in respect of such goats for the year in which it is directed that it should be paid.

6. The Governor may, by order published in the *Gazette*, suspend the operation of this Law. Suspension of operation of Law.

7. This Law shall come into operation on the 31st day of December, 1948, and, thereupon, the Laws set out in the Schedule hereto shall be repealed to the extent specified therein. Date of commencement and repeals.
