A Law to amend the Game and Wild Birds Laws, 1934 to 1947.

Officer Administering the Government.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Officer Administering the Government and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Game and Wild Birds short title. (Amendment) Law, 1949, and shall be read as one with the Game and Wild Birds Laws, 1934 to 1947 (hereinafter 3 of 1934 referred to as "the principal Law"), and the principal Law 23 of 1938 and this Law may together be cited as the Game and Wild 19 of 1947 Birds Laws, 1934 to 1949.

Amendment of section 2 of the principal Law.

- 2. Section 2 of the principal Law is hereby amended as follows:—
 - (a) by the deletion therefrom of the definition "Close Season" (as set out in Law 19 of 1947) and the substitution therefor of the following definition:—
 - "'Close Season' means the period between the 1st February and the 30th September, both days inclusive, in every year or any other period as may be prescribed by the Governor in Council, under the provisions of this Law, to be a Close Season.";
 - (b) by the insertion therein in its proper alphabetical order of the following definition:—
 - "'Dealer in Game' means a person licensed to deal in game under the provisions of this Law;".

Insertion of new section 2A in the principal Law. 3. The principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion therein, immediately after section 2, of the following section:—

"Power to Governor in Council to prescribe other period of Close Season. 2A. The Governor in Council may, by order to be published in the *Gazette*, prescribe any period in any year to be a Close Season and such period as may be specified in the order shall, during the continuance of such order, be deemed to be the Close Season for the purposes of this Law."

Amendment of section 3 of the principal Law.

- 4. Section 3 of the principal Law is hereby amended as follows:—
 - (a) by the deletion in sub-section (1) of the words "Any person who acts in contravention of this sub-section shall be guilty of an offence under this Law.":
 - (b) by the insertion therein, immediately after subsection (1), of the following sub-section:—
 - "(1A) Any person who acts in contravention of sub-section (1) of this section shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months or to a fine not exceeding twenty-five pounds or to both."

5. Sub-section (1) of section 4 of the principal Law is Deletion of hereby deleted and the following sub-section substituted section 4 (1) therefor:

and substitution of new sub-section.

- "(1) A Game Licence shall be in the Form A in the First Schedule hereto and may be granted by the Commissioner to any person who-
 - (a) is the holder of a Firearms Licence under the Firearms Laws, 1933 to 1942; and
 - (b) being the holder of a Game Licence during the immediately preceding season, satisfies the Commissioner that, during such season, he has killed not less than six crows or magpies:

Provided that paragraph (b) of this sub-section shall not apply-

- (i) to any Game Licence to be granted to any person before the 1st day of August, 1950, or to be granted after that date to any person who is on a temporary visit to Cyprus:
- (ii) to any person who applies for a Game Licence for the first time or during a season immediately following the . making of an order by the Governor under paragraph (a) of section 6 (1) of this Law which does not exempt crows and magpies from its operation or who was absent from the Colony during the season, not being a Close Season, immediately preceding:

Provided further that the Governor may, at any time by notice in the Gazette, suspend the operation of paragraph (b) of this sub-section for such time as may be specified in the notice."

6. Section 5 of the principal Law is hereby amended Amendment as follows :-

(a) by the deletion in paragraph (b) of the proviso principal to sub-section (1) thereof of the words "sparrows, thrushes, blackbirds, larks, beccaficos, doves, pigeons, starlings, crows, jackdaws, ravens, magpies and hawks" (lines 3, 4 and 5) and the substitution therefor of the words "wild birds in general or such wild birds as may be specified in the endorsement,";

of section 5 of the

- (b) by the deletion therefrom of sub-section (2) and the substitution therefor of the following section :-
 - "(2) Any person who acts in contravention of sub-section (1) of this section shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months or to a fine not exceeding twenty-five pounds or to both."

Insertion of new sections 6A, 6B and 6C in the principal Law.

7. The principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion therein, immediately after section 6, of the following sections :-

" Restric. tions of sale of game by holders of a Game Licence.

- 6A.—(1) No holder of a Game Licence shall sell any game except to a Dealer in Game, unless he is himself a Dealer in Game.
- (2) Any person who acts in contravention of sub-section (1) of this section shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months or to a fine not exceeding twenty-five pounds or to both.

6B.—(1) Subject to the provisions of section 6A of this Law, no person shall sell or otherwise dispose of any game to any member of the public, unless he is the holder of a licence as a Dealer in Game.

(2) Any person who acts in contravention

of sub-section (1) of this section shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months or to a fine not exceeding twenty-five pounds or to both.

6c.—(1) Any person who wishes to obtain a licence as a Dealer in Game shall apply to the Commissioner specifying his name and residence and the place or premises at which he proposes to sell or dispose of game and the Commissioner, upon the payment of a fee of five shillings, shall grant to him a licence to be a Dealer in Game in the Form B in the First Schedule hereto and such licence shall exhibited by the holder in a conspicuous place, in the place or premises at which he proposes to sell or dispose of game:

Provided that the Commissioner may refuse to grant a licence to any person to be a Dealer in Game if such person is convicted for an offence under the provisions of this section.

No sale of game to the public except by Dealers in Game.

Dealers in Game to be licensed and keep book.

- (2) Every Dealer in Game shall keep a book wherein he shall enter or cause to be entered true and accurate particulars on the several matters set out in the Second Schedule hereto.
- (3) Any Dealer in Game who contravention of sub-section (1) or (2) of this section shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months or to a fine exceeding twenty-five pounds or to both."
- 8. Section 21 of the principal Law is hereby amended Amendment by the deletion therefrom of the words "and shall in of section 21 addition be prohibited from carrying a gun for a period of principal not less than twelve months or more than five years", Law. (lines 4, 5 and 6).

9. Section 22 of the principal Law is hereby repealed Repeal of and the following section substituted therefor:-

" Consequences following conviction.

22. Where any person is convicted of an offence under this Law-

section 22 of the principal Law and substitution of new section.

- (a) he shall in addition to any other penalty be prohibited from carrying a gun for a period of not less than twelve months or more than five years;
- (b) any gun in respect of which the offence has been committed, being the property of such person, shall be forfeited;
- (c) any licence granted to such person under this Law shall be forfeited."
- 10. The First Schedule to the principal Law is hereby Amendment amended by the insertion therein of the following Form B:
