A LAW TO AMEND THE PROPERTY OF HIS MAJESTY
(THEFT AND POSSESSION) LAW.A. B. WRIGHT,
Governor.

[6th November, 1951.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :—

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Property of His Majesty (Theft and Possession) Amendment Law, 1951, and shall be read as one with the Property of His Majesty (Theft and Possession) Law (which continues in operation by Order in Council No. 2453 made on the 21st day of December, 1950) hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law."

2. Section 4 of the principal Law is hereby repealed.

Repeal of section 4 of the principal Law.

Date of coming into operation.

3. This Law shall come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1952.
