## THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS

No. 30 of 1954.

A Law to amend the Interpretation Law.

Governor.

DE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :-

1. This Law may be cited as the Interpretation (Amendment No. 2) Law, 1954, and shall be read as one with the Interpretation Law (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Cap. 1

Amendment of section 2 of the principal Law.

- 2. Section 2 of the principal Law is hereby amended as follows:—
  - (a) by the deletion therefrom of the definition of "Member" (inserted by section 2 of Law 19 of

(b) by the substitution for the definition of "Crown Agents" contained therein of the following defini-

tion:-

"'Crown Agents' means the persons for the time being acting as Crown Agents for Oversea Governments and Administrations in England, or any of them;".

Amendment of the principal Law by the insertion of a new section 22A.

3. The principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion therein, immediately after section 22, of the following new section:—

"Signification of Orders, etc., of the Governor-in-Council.

22A. Where any Law confers upon the Governor in Council power to make any public instrument or appointment, give any directions, issue any Order, authorize any thing or matter to be done, grant any exemption, remit any fee or penalty or exercise any other power, it shall be sufficient if the exercise of such power by the Governor in Council be signified under the hand of the Clerk of the Executive Council.".

Change of title of Crown Agents.

4. The words "Crown Agents for the Colonies" in any Law or public instrument shall be substituted by the words "Crown Agents for Oversea Governments and Administrations".

Amendment of section 23 of the principal Law. 5. Section 23 of the principal Law (as set out in section 3 of Law 19 of 1954) is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "a Member" (line 8) of the words "the Colonial Secretary, the Attorney-General or the Financial Secretary.".

Date of commence-ment.

6. This Law shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of April, 1954.
