A Law to amend the Recovery of Compensation FOR INJURY TO PROPERTY LAW.

DE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :-

Short title.

Cap. 146

I. This Law may be cited as the Recovery of Compensation for Injury to Property (Amendment) Law, 1954, and shall be read as one with the Recovery of Compensation for Injury to Property Law (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law").

2. Section 3 of the principal Law is hereby amended as Amendment follows :-

(a) by the substitution in the second proviso to subsection (1) for the words "ten shillings" (lines 2 and 3) of the words "one pound";

(b) by the substitution in the proviso to sub-section (2) for the words "five shillings" (line 3) of the words "ten shillings".

3. Section 8 of the principal Law is hereby amended as Amendment follows :-

(a) by the substitution in sub-paragraph (i) of paragraph (b) of sub-section (4) for the words "four piastres" (line 3) of the words "one shilling";

(b) by the substitution in sub-paragraph (ii) of paragraph (b) of sub-section (4) for the words "one shilling" (line 3) of the words "two shillings".

4. Section 10 of the principal Law is hereby amended as Amendment follows :-

(a) by the substitution in sub-section (4) for the words principal "five pounds" (line 7) and "one week" (line 8) of the words "ten pounds" and "two weeks", respectively;

(b) by the substitution in sub-section (5) for the words "one month" (line 8) and "five pounds" (line 10) of the words "two months" and "ten pounds", respectively;

(c) by the substitution in sub-section (7) for the words "two pounds" (lines 3 and 4) and "one week" (lines 4 and 5) of the words "five pounds" and "two weeks", respectively.

5. Section 13 of the principal Law is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "one hundred" (line 2) and 13 of the fifty" (line 4) of the words "four hundred" and "two principal Law. hundred", respectively.

6. Sub-section (1) of section 20 of the principal Law is Amendment hereby amended by the substitution for the words "ten of the pounds" (line 19) of the words "twenty pounds".
