## A LAW TO AMEND THE EXCHANGE CONTROL LAW.

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

Short title.

**1.** This Law may be cited as the Exchange Control (Amendment) Law, 1954, and shall be read as one with the Exchange Control Law, 1952 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law") and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Exchange Control Laws, 1952 and 1954.

2. The provisions of the principal Law set out in the first column of the Schedule shall have effect subject to the minor amendments set out in relation thereto in the second column of the Schedule.

Minor amendments to the principal Law. Schedule.

SCHEDULE.

(Section 2.)

First Column.	Second Column.
Section 2	By substituting for the word "sterling" in sub-section (4) (lines 2 and 7) of the words "local currency".
Section 3	By substituting for the word "sterling" in paragraph (a) of sub-section (4) (line 5) of the words "local currency".
Section 6	By substituting for the word "sterling" in sub-section (3) (line 1) and in sub-section (4) (line 3) of the words "local currency".
Section 24	By substituting for the word "sterling" in sub-paragraph (d) (iii) of sub-section (1) (line 2) of the words "that of a scheduled territory and payable otherwise than within scheduled territories".
Section 26	By substituting for the word "sterling" in sub-section (1) (wherever it occurs) and in sub-section (2) (line 3) of the words "local currency".
Section 29	By substituting for the word "sterling" in sub-section (1) (line 3) of the words "local currency".
Second Schedule	By inserting in the heading in the brackets after the words "Section 32" of the words "and Section 34".
Fifth Schedule	By deleting— (a) the words "of not more than twenty-five pounds" from sub-paragraph (3) (a) of paragraph 1 of Part II (line 2); (b) the words "of not more than three hundred pounds" from sub-paragraph (3) (b) of paragraph 1 of Part II (line 2). By substituting for the words "one hundred" in sub-paragraph (4) (a) of paragraph 1 of Part II (line 1) of the words "two hundred".
