Short title. Cap. 170. 41 of 1953 33 of 1954. 1. This Law may be cited as the Tobacco (Amendment) Law, 1955, and shall be read as one with the Tobacco Law (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law").

Amendment of section 16 of the principal Law. 2. Sub-section (3) of section 16 of the principal Law is hereby repealed and the following sub-section substituted therefor:—

"(3) A fee of five shillings shall be charged for the issue of a dealer's licence.".

A Law to amend the Municipal Corporations Law.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Municipal Corporations (Amendment) Law, 1955, and shall be read as one with the Municipal Corporations Law (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law").

2. Section 162 of the principal Law is hereby amended as Amendment follows-(a) by the deletion from sub-section (1) thereof of the principal

words "reside or" (line 4);

(b) by the substitution for sub-section (2) thereof of the following sub-section:—

"(2) The fees provided for by sub-section (1) of this section shall be payable in two half annual instalments on the thirtieth day of June and the thirty-first day of December of each year:

Provided that no such payment shall be made if the officer has not for the period of six months preceding any such date performed his duties within

any municipal limits.".
