A LAW TO AMEND THE CURFEWS LAW, 1955.

Governor.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Curfews (Amendment) Law, 1955, and shall be read as one with the Curfews Law, 1955 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law"), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Curfews Laws, 1955.

2. The principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion therein of the following new section :—

2A. The Governor may, by instrument under his hand to be published in the *Gazette*, delegate to any person, subject to such limitations and directions as he may in such instrument provide, any of the powers conferred upon him by the provisions of section 2 of this Law."
