THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS

No. 3 OF 1956.

A LAW TO TRANSFER CERTAIN STATUTORY POWERS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY AND TO THE DIRECTOR THEREOF.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Department of Commerce Short title, and Industry (Transfer of Powers) Law, 1956.

Interpretation.

- 2.—(1) In this Law, unless the context otherwise requires—
 “Department” means the Department of Commerce and Industry;
 “Director” means the Director of Commerce and Industry to the Government.

(2) In all Laws and public instruments, enacted, made, issued, kept or in use, after the commencement of this Law, the expression “Director of Commerce and Industry” shall mean the Director of Commerce and Industry to the Government.

References in certain Laws deemed to be references to Director and Department of Commerce and Industry. First Schedule.

3. Notwithstanding anything in any Law, public instrument, public notice or other document to the contrary contained—

(a) all references in the Laws specified in the first column of the First Schedule hereto, and in any public instrument, public notice or other document made or issued under any such Law, to the public officer specified in the second column of the said Schedule, shall be deemed to be references to the Director;

(b) all references in the Laws specified in the first column of the Second Schedule hereto, and in any public instrument, public notice or other document made or issued under any such Law, to the Government Department specified in the second column of the said Schedule, or to any officer of such Department, shall be deemed to be references to the Department or to an officer of the Department, respectively.

Second Schedule.

Amendment of Schedules.

4. The Governor in Council may, by Order, vary, alter, add to or otherwise amend the Schedules to this Law.

Date of commencement.

5. This Law shall come into operation on the first day of February, 1956.
