**THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS**

**No. 5 OF 1956.**

A LAW TO REGULARIZE CERTAIN PAYMENTS MADE IN THE  
TWELVE MONTHS ENDED ON THE THIRTY-FIRST  
DAY OF DECEMBER, 1954.

**W**HEREAS the Appropriation Law, 1954, made certain 27 of 1954.  
provision for defraying the charges of the Govern-  
ment of Cyprus for the twelve months ended on the thirty-  
first day of December, 1954, and whereas it is necessary to  
make certain additional provision for the public service  
for the said period.

BE it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor  
and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as  
follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Supplementary Short title.  
Appropriation Law, 1956.

Supplementary appropriation of £3,767,071 for the twelve months ended the 31st December, 1954.  
27 of 1954.

2. The sums of money set forth in the Schedule to this Law, having been expended in respect of the establishments or services therein mentioned beyond the amounts granted for those services for the twelve months ended on the thirty-first day of December, 1954, by the Appropriation Law, 1954, such sums are hereby declared to have been duly laid out and expended in defraying the charges of the Government of Cyprus for those twelve months and are hereby approved, allowed and granted in addition to the sums mentioned for those establishments and services in the said Law.
