A LAW TO AMEND THE SHEEP, GOATS AND PIGS
(ENUMERATION) LAW.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and
Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as
follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Sheep, Goats and Pigs (Enumeration) (Amendment) Law, 1956, and shall be read as one with the Sheep, Goats and Pigs (Enumeration) Law (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law").

2. The definition of "enumerator" contained in section 2 of the principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion therein, immediately after the words "police officer" (line 1), of the words "or other person".
