## THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS

No. 13 of 1957.

A Law to amend the Water (Domestic Purposes) Village Supplies Law.

CAP. 311. 28 of 1951 12 of 1952.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Water (Domestic Purposes) Short title. Village Supplies (Amendment) Law, 1957, and shall be read as one Cap. 311 with the Water (Domestic Purposes) Village Supplies Law (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law").

Insertion of new section 18A in the principal Law.

2. The principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion therein, immediately after section 18, of the following new section:—

"Power of Village Water Commission to grant easements, etc.

18A. Notwithstanding anything in this Law contained, a Village Water Commission may, with the consent of the Commissioner and subject to any terms or conditions he may deem fit to impose, grant easements or any other right or advantage over any immovable property or waterworks belonging to the Village Water Commission:

Provided that the Commissioner shall not give his consent under this section unless he is satisfied that the proposed grant—

(a) is not prejudicial to the interests of the inhabitants of the village; and

(b) will not be detrimental to the supply of water for domestic purposes to the village.".

Date of commencement. 3. This Law shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of January, 1954.
