A Law to amend the Customs Management Laws, 1954 and 1955.

DE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Customs Management (Amend-Short title. ment) Law, 1957, and shall be read as one with the Customs Management Laws, 1954 and 1955 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law"), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Customs Management Laws, 1954 to 1957.

Repeal of section 11 of the principal Law.

Amendment of section 147 of the principal Law.

Repeal of section 194 of the principal Law and substitution of new section.

2. Section 11 of the principal Law is hereby repealed.

3. Sub-section (2) of section 147 of the principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion therein, immediately after the word "equipment" (line 2), of the words "imported and subsequently".

4. Section 194 of the principal Law is hereby repealed and the

following section substituted therefor: -

"Disposal of 194. All forfeited vessels, means of conveyance and forfeited goods shall be disposed of in such manner as the Compvessels, troller may direct: goods, etc.

> Provided that the Governor may direct that any such forfeited vessels, means of conveyance or goods shall be released and restored to the person from whom it was seized or to the owner thereof, upon such terms and

conditions as the Governor may think fit".

Amendment of section 205 of the principal Law.

5. Section 205 of the principal Law is hereby amended by the addition at the end of paragraph (r) thereof of the following proviso (the full stop at the end of the said paragraph (r) being substituted by a colon):-

"Provided further that nothing in this paragraph contained shall apply to any foreign manufactured tobacco contained in a container printed or distinguished with such identification mark as the Comptroller may approve.".
