## THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS

## No. 32 of 1957.

A LAW TO AMEND THE SECONDARY EDUCATION LAW. 18 of 1952 G. E. SINCLAIR,] 27th November, 1957. 20 of 1954 Officer Administering the Government. 26 of 1956.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Officer Administering the Government and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :---

Short title . 1. This Law may be cited as the Secondary Education (Amendment) Law, 1957, and shall be read as one with the Secondary Education Law (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law").

Amendment of section 24 of the principal Law. **2.** Sub-section (1) of section 22 of the principal Law is hereby amended by the deletion of the words from " or to have used or be using" down to and including the word " teaching " in lines 6 to 10 and the substitution therefor of the following :—

" or where the Director is satisfied that such teacher has been or is conducting himself in a manner prejudicial to the interests of education, religion, good government or social order in the Colony, or is guilty of misconduct, neglect of duty or inefficiency in his office of teacher, the Director may interdict such teacher from teaching ".

**3.** Sub-section (2) of section 24 of the principal Law (as set out in section 2 of Law 18 of 1952) is hereby amended by the substitution of a colon for the full stop at the end of paragraph (b) and the addition thereto of the following proviso :—

"Provided that the Governor shall be at liberty to appoint a governing body of five members for any Moslem secondary school or schools in any village not being a municipal corporation and thereupon the provisions of this sub-section shall apply to such governing body and the same shall be deemed to be a governing body for the purposes of this Law.".
