The sums of money set forth in the Schedule to this Law, having been expended in respect of the establishments or services therein mentioned beyond the amounts provided for those services for the twelve months ended on the thirty-first day of December, 1957, by the Appropriation Law, 1957, such sums are hereby declared to have been duly laid out and expended in defraying the charges of the Government of Cyprus for those twelve months and are hereby approved, allowed and granted in addition to the sums mentioned for those establishments and services in the said Law.

A LAW TO APPROPRIATE A SUM NOT EXCEEDING TWENTY-FOUR MILLION, FIVE HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT THOUSAND, ONE HUNDRED AND NINETY-SEVEN POUNDS TO THE SERVICE OF THE TWELVE MONTHS ENDING THE THIRTY-FIRST DAY OF DECEMBER, IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTY-EIGHT.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is necessary to make provision for such expenses of the Government of Cyprus for the year ending the thirty-first day of December, 1958, as are not already lawfully provided for or shall not hereafter be provided for by any Law.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :—

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Appropriation Law, 1958.

2. In addition to the sums already lawfully appropriated to the service of the Queen or which may be hereafter lawfully appropriated thereto, there shall be issued and applied to the service of the twelve months ending the thirty-first day of December, 1958, out of the revenue and other funds of the Colony, any sum not exceeding the sum of Twenty Million, Four Hundred and Ninety-One Thousand One Hundred and Thirty-Four Pounds for defraying the charge of the Government of Cyprus for such period as set out in columns (3) and (4) of the Schedule and there shall be issued also and applied to the service of the twelve months ending the thirty-first day of December, 1958, out of the Development Fund of the Colony any sum not exceeding the sum of Four Million, Eighty-Seven Thousand and Sixty-Three Pounds for defraying the charge of the Government of Cyprus for such period as set out in column (5) of the Schedule.

3. A sum not exceeding the amount set down under each head in the Schedule may be issued and spent in respect of the Establishment or Service specified and referred to therein.

4. This Law shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1958.
