Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Cyprus Volunteer I Law.

Interpretation.

2. In this Law—

"Army Act" means the Army Act, 1881 (44 ar Vict., c. 58), of the United Kingdom, and include Acts amending or substituted for the same an articles of war thereunder in force;

"Commanding Officer" used in relation to the I means the Commanding Officer of the Force apport under section 9 or in his absence the next senior o actually present and doing duty with the Force;

" Force" means the Cyprus Volunteer Force formed under this Law:

"officer" means a person holding the Governor's commission as an officer of the Force;

"other rank" means warrant officers, non-commissioned officers and privates of the Force;

"recruiting officer" means a person appointed under section 6 to enlist other ranks.

It shall be lawful for the Governor whenever it appears Fower of sable to do so by reason of the existence of a state of war form Force. f the apprehension of war or by reason of any internal

gency threatening the security of life or property to a Force to be called "the Cyprus Volunteer Force" a view to assisting the regular forces in the Colony or Cyprus police force or both in all measures required
